## Keynote Speakers



**ROCCO ALFANO** is graduated in Law at the University of Salerno on October 4, 1993, with a grade of 110/110 cum laude. He attended the Forensic Course at the University of Salerno for the academic year 1993/94 and passed the examinations of legal attorney in 1995. In 1997 he achieved the **post-graduate Diploma of Specialization in Administrative Law and science of administration**, discussing a thesis entitled “The Judicial and Administrative Protection of the Private Contractor” (final vote 48/50) at the Faculty of Law of the University of Naples "Federico II". He was the **Municipal Secretary** of the Municipality of Corniglio (Parma) from September 1996 to September 1997, attending and passing the Training Course for

Municipal Secretaries at the Higher School of the Internal Administration with merit. **He was honorary fellow of Constitutional Law** at the University of Salerno, taking part in studies and research activities and the examination committee. Rocco Alfano has been serving as **Deputy Public Prosecutor** at the Court of Salerno since 30 September 1999; **DDA Deputy Prosecutor** at the Court of Salerno from 27 June 2011 to 22 October 2018; **Antiterrorism Deputy Prosecutor** at the Court of Salerno from 30 June 2015 to 22. October 2018; **Adjoint Deputy Public Prosecutor** at the Court of Salerno appointed by resolution of the CSM of September 19, 2018, entering into the aforementioned functions on October 22, 2018, until 30 June 2021; Deputy Public Prosecutor at the Court of Salerno appointed to the DDA since 1 July 2021 and Deputy Public Prosecutor at the Court of Salerno appointed to the Intersectional Group of Investigation on Terrorism since 29 September 2021.
