She is alumna of the Study of the U.S. Institutes, CEEPUS, ERASMUS and OEAD programs, local coordinator of the CEEPUS network “Ethics and politics in European context” and former member of the Commission for international cooperation of the Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje. She has participated in numerous research and other projects including Horizon 2020, Erasmus, Jean Monnet, TEMPUS, COST and CEEPUS programs.
